# ORDINANCE NO. 2017- <u>O(</u> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PARKING BAN ON ALL VILLAGE STREETS WHEN SNOW ACCUMULATION EXCEEDS 2 INCHES

WHEREAS, the Village of Big Rock is a municipal corporation duly organized and operating pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, in Year 2009, the Village of Big Rock approved Ordinance No. 2009-27 which prohibited the parking of vehicles on Village streets when snow accumulation exceeded 2 inches, and which imposed a fine of \$25.00 for a violation of this parking ban; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Big Rock Board of Trustees desires to amend said parking ban to authorize the towing of vehicles upon a second violation of the parking ban, and also desires to amend the parking ban to further clarify when vehicles can resume parking on Village streets after a snow event; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is approved pursuant to the Village's police powers, pursuant to authority granted under the Illinois Municipal Code, and is approved to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Big Rock, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1: The above-stated Recitals are hereby restated and incorporated into this Section 1 as though fully set forth herein.
- Section 2: The parking ban on all Village streets when snow accumulation exceeds 2 inches, as approved by Ordinance No. 2009-27, is hereby amended in its entirety to state as follows:
  - (A) The parking of vehicles on Village streets is prohibited when snow accumulation exceeds two inches (2"), as measured at the Aurora airport.
  - (B) Vehicles may resume parking on Village streets once such snow events have ended and all snow and ice removal activities related to said snow events have ceased.
  - (C) The first violation of this ordinance may result in the issuance of a Village citation and a fine in the amount of \$25.00. The citation shall be placed on the windshield of the vehicle, or other convenient location on the vehicle. If the vehicle is covered with heavy snow accumulation, the Village may mail the citation to the address of the registered owner of the vehicle.
  - (D) The second violation and subsequent violations of this ordinance by the same vehicle (during the same or different snow event) may result in the towing of the vehicle at the owner's expense by the Village.

Section 3: The Village shall post signs regarding this parking ban at major entrances into the Village, including but not limited to U.S. Route 30 and Granart Road. The Village President may authorize the posting of such additional signage at additional locations as he deems necessary and as the Village's budget permits.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
