AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE BID OF \$32,871.50
AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH Meyers Paving
FOR THE JEFFERSON / 1ST STREET PAVING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Village of Big Rock is a municipal corporation duly organized and operating pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village, through its consulting engineer, prepared a bid package and publically advertised for bids for the Jefferson / 1st Street Paving Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village publicly opened and read the bids which were timely received, and the bid of Meyers Paving in the amount of \$ 32,871.50 was the lowest bid received and was below the engineer's estimate for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees desires to accept the bid of \$32,871.50 for the afore-mentioned street restoration project, finding this bid to constitute the lowest responsible bid, and finding this bidder to be qualified to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees further desires to authorize the execution of a contract with Meyers Paving for the street paving project, finding this work will benefit the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Big Rock, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: The above-stated Recitals are hereby restated and incorporated into this Section 1 as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The bid of Meyers Paving for the Jefferson / 1st Street Paving Project in the amount of \$ 32,871.50 is hereby accepted as the lowest responsible and responsive bid.

Section 3: The Village Attorney and the Village's consulting engineer are directed to prepare a contract between the Village and Meyers Paving for this street paving project, with said contract to be consistent with the bid documents and the accepted bid. The Village President is authorized and directed to execute said contract once it is finalized by the Village Attorney and consulting engineer, without the need for further Board of Trustees' approval.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
