DRAINAGE COMMITTEE REPORT Wastewater Final Completion/Warranty Issues

- -Per the village attorney no updates on the pending lawsuit yet.
- -Darrin contacted Dean about a meter that has gone bad at the wastewater treatment facility. This is a key piece that delivers electronic information on flow data, etc... to Darrin & Dean. This will need to get fixed as soon as possible.
- -Dean received a call from an upset resident in Tenerrelli that needs their ditch filled in. The board has been discussing this for a while however there needs to be money in the SSA to pay for this. More details to follow.

STREET MAINTENANCE REPORT

- -Dean sent the report from IDOT about the Hinckley Rd. bridge to the village board. It's in a critical status! For the time being a metal plate is acceptable until further notice per the engineering firm & IDOT. HLR engineering firm is starting the process of looking for grant monies for the village and the new bridge construction.
- -The village is going to still attempt to go out for bid this year for the re-surfacing of its portion of Hinckley Rd. The village will also look to add gravel to the shoulders and make the road/shoulder a bit wider.

DEPT. OF BUILDING/SAFETY/ZONING REPORT

Kane County Police Services

-The village received its first bill from the policing services. Mark is going to follow-up and request some more details on the bills.

FINANCIAL REPORT MFT Resolution

-The municipal estimate of maintenance costs were discussed for the MFT money allocations. More details to follow when the resolution is passed.

COMMUNITY REPORT IGA w/ Township

-Dean met with Wade (highway commissioner) to discuss signing a contract for providing services to the village (snow plowing, mowing, etc..). Details are being worked on and the meeting went very well.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

- -Trains have been excessively blowing horns and blocking the tracks again. The village will attempt reaching out to the BNSF again about these disturbances.
- -Donation to the Cub Scouts for a specific event was discussed.
- -Donation to the Big Rock Plowing Match Association was discussed. A \$1,000 donation was placed on the table for board approval at an upcoming meeting.
- -McCannon Farms October Fest after the Plowing Match is this upcoming weekend.....everyone is welcome per Ted.

- -Crawford property was discussed and the need for the property owner to get into compliance before the village talks about negotiating any of the fines/fees.
