DRAINAGE COMMITTEE REPORT Wastewater Final Completion/Warranty Issues, Sewer Install/Damage Fund

- -The litigation letter to H. Linden & Sons, their bond company, & ATI is still pending the village attorney review before being sent out. John had some remaining questions that needed clarification. A couple of the village trustees are getting frustrated with the delays. John apologizes how long it's taken to get this process rolling.
- -Dean asked Tim to communicate to Darrin that some items need to be picked up from RayVac and delivered to the wwtp for storage.
- -A very basic policy will be drafted about any work that is needed on residents property for which there has been damage as a direct result of the sanitary sewer system installation.

STREET MAINTENANCE REPORT

- -Kathy is in communication(s) with the fire chief about possibly doing some culvert cleaning throughout Rhodes Rd. Details to follow about her conversations with John R.
- -O'Donnell Excavating & Trucking will be finishing up the post office intersection and then starting the sidewalk project this week. Tim spoke with Kolt today about this time line.
- -The board asked Tim to check with Kolt about removing some concrete pieces of sidewalk at the end of Jefferson St. (106 Jefferson Ave.)

DEPT. OF BUILDING/SAFETY/ZONING REPORT

- -With the winter season fast approaching (and things slowing up) the board feels that Jorge can properly maintain review of the village while working one time a week instead of twice. Tim will convey this to TPI and Jorge right away.
- -The village attorney is still working on the policy to outline procedures for residents whom choose not comply with the village ordinances and/or violation notices. This will include notice of fines and court dates set up for offenders that cannot comply within the specified time frames. Those residents that are asking for extensions and/or have extenuating circumstances must communicate with the village office and board.

-The village is still waiting for its invoice from Silver Edge Consultants for recent street resurfacing engineering. It will need this	prior
to commencing any further services with Silver Edge Consultants.
