DRAINAGE COMMITTEE REPORT Wastewater Final Completion/Warranty Issues

-John & Dean have continued to work with Orenco. The village is eager to get its report that was requested awhile back and then also get a date scheduled for the remaining tele grouting to be completed.

-Darrin attended the recent wastewater meeting and suggested the village start to pump tanks. It was also requested that he purchase some additional parts to keep on hand at the treatment facility for repairs, etc... The board agreed this was ok to purchase.

STREET MAINTENANCE REPORT Rempe-Sharpe Invoice, Granart Rd.

-O'Donnell Excavating patched some potholes throughout the village roads. The board still has to decide what areas are going to get some resurfacing and/or a more permanent fix of some sort.

-The railroad crossing is still closed on Rhodes Rd. We will look into getting a timeframe upon which we can expect it to be reopened and repaired.

-Granart Road bridge at Welsh Creek will need some repairing this season also. A Kane County deputy stopped by the office last week and expressed his concerns with the deterioration of the road, and bridge, along with questioning the villages speed limit sign(s).

-Dean had a conversation with Jim Bibby (Rempe-Sharpe) last week. They would like to be paid as soon as possible and Jim reminded Dean that they were not hired to oversee the project but rather to simply just do the engineering plans. Rempe-Sharpe also agreed to be the villages liaison between the other entities (BNSF, FRA, IDOT). The village will review the contract it signed awhile back and then decide how to proceed with the current invoice.
