DRAINAGE COMMITTEE REPORT

Wastewater Final Completion/Warranty Issues, Sewer Install/Damage Fund

-Will Shimkus received a proposal from Connelly Electric for sealing all the electrical boxes on the septic tanks.

-A resident from the Tenerrelli subdivision phoned the village office about some drainage issues. Dean/Will are going to reach out to her and obtain some specific information and help answer any questions.

-The board discussed purchasing rings for all the riser/lids on the septic tanks. This would ensure a tight waterproof seal. More details to come. Tim will reach out to Darrin about a couple damaged lids that need immediate replacement.

STREET MAINTENANCE REPORT

-The board would like to get separate estimates for repaying a couple specific streets (Timberview, Welton, Post Office) and then also areas along Rhodes Rd. that are in need of repair to prevent further deterioration.

-Estimates for the sidewalk project along $5^{th}/6^{th}$ street were received. This project will be put on the contractors calendar to do as soon as possible. Tim will notify the resident(s) whom will be primarily effected with some retaining wall bricks that are located in the right of way.

-The post office intersection reconfiguration/project is still being discussed and another estimate is being sought after.

DEPT. OF BUILDING/SAFETY/ZONING REPORT

-Dean received a call from a resident on rte 30 whom recently received a property maintenance violation. They were upset and requested to meet Dean in person to discuss. The meeting with the property owner went well and things were resolved amicably.

-Jorge has a few properties that continue to be in violation and have not made the requested changes. The board was in favor of moving forward and having the village attorney handle appropriately.

-The villages financial position was discussed briefly upon request from a resident in attendance.

COMMUNITY REPORT

-The question arose from a resident about the village obtaining yard waste stickers to sell to the public from our preferred garbage provider (Groot). Tim will look into this and report back.
