STREET MAINTENANCE REPORT

- -Granart Rd. is slowly getting completed with its new asphalt overlay. Union guys delayed the project along with a couple mechanical issues. Dean also had a lengthy conversation with Geneva Construction regarding the village using a non-union contractor.....the village then received a FOIA request. Tim submit everything requested in the FOIA within the allowable time frame.
- -Clay & Matt would like to see a truck restriction limitation on Granart Rd especially that it will have a brand new asphalt job. Matt did research how another local municipality has done this same thing which has reduced its truck traffic significantly. The village will have to work with the Big Rock Township and Sugar Grove to post this signage in their jurisdiction because Granart Rd. is a shared road. More details to follow on this.

DEPT. OF BUILDING/SAFETY/ZONING REPORT

- -Wade has been working with Tim recently to help obtain new "no train horn" signs ordered from BlackBerry Township and then erected at the crossing. Seems the signage on the south side of the tracks was hit and then someone took the signs.
- -There will be a PZC hearing on Monday October 14th at the Fire Station. Topics it will include are: Joshua Rodgers variance request for his new garage/accessory structure at 7s286 Madison St. Additionally the cell tower special use for a telecommunications tower at 47w863 Second St. (a.k.a. Big Rock Fire Protection District).

-Matt spoke with Spencer at Kane County regarding the property at 206 Lincoln St. The property needs to be cleaned up along with safety concerns addressed. There has been an open permit for 3 years and someone needs to follow-up with this.

FINANCIAL REPORT

-The village audit was recently completed successfully. Everything went very smooth again this year and Sikich was able to finish earlier than anticipated.
